In northern Germany, the Christmas Man (Weihnachtsmann), or, as he was known in parts of Saxony, Pelze Nichol, came alone. He carried a switch as well as small gifts. If a child could not recite a Bible verse on demand, or if parents said a child had been naughty, he or she got switched. This custom continued in some parts of Germany well into the 1950s and was part of Midwest regional customs, too. Whatever his local name, this fierce, unfriendly, costumed figure was intended to bring home to children the shortness and savageness of life. Today, the furry costume and frightening switches are mere props for a much more mellow Pelze Nichol, who delights his audiences with songs and witty tales of days gone by.
